







An introduction to Dipont Education

Committed to developing, guiding and empowering our students

Dipont Education Management Group is a leading Chinese educational services company with a particular focus on the delivery of western curricula to Chinese students.

In association with highly regarded public Chinese high schools, we currently manage 11 A Level Centers (UK curriculum) and 6 AP Centers (U.S. curriculum) in a range of locations across China. Demand for our foreign curricula provision is extremely high and we are expanding our existing centers, developing new programs (including an International Baccalaureate provision) and opening in new locations over the next few years.

At present, Dipont has over 300 Chinese employees and 190 foreign teaching staff. We have over 3,200 students currently studying in our centers and envision this increasing to 6,000 students in the next two years across at least 20 centers. Our counseling staff includes full-time Chinese college counselors supported by a team of senior expatriate counselors and recent U.S. college graduates.

Making international education accessible

A number of our students achieve some of the highest examination results globally and continue their education at the best universities in the world. As well as academic achievement, each center also strives to encourage confidence and independence in their students in order to ensure that they are well prepared for their university careers. Through the program and their studies in the English medium, students develop awareness of other cultures and an international perspective, but at the same time retain strong ties to their Chinese heritage.

Students in our A-Level and AP centers are provided with in-school, college and university counseling as a standard component of our education programs. In addition, we also offer students in certain centers the opportunity to enroll in an advanced college counseling program, which includes counseling by experienced expatriate college counselors, interaction with recent graduates of top U.S. colleges, extracurricular support, and SAT and TOEFL preparation. Students involved in our counseling programs also have the opportunity to attend summer college admissions camps in China and academic summer programs at U.S. universities run by the Council for American Culture and Education (CACE), a U.S. non-profit organization and Dipont partner.



Professional counseling programs for Chinese students

Dipont is committed to developing the highest quality counseling program possible for Chinese students keen to study at university level abroad. Our philosophy is to combine and coordinate the experience and expertise of a range of staff: expatriate teaching faculty, senior expatriate counselors, Chinese college counselors and recent U.S graduates, to provide the best possible support, advice and guidance to students.

All students in our centers receive standard in-school support from our college counselors, and our centers use Naviance for electronic submission of applications. Students who wish to receive additional college counseling support have the option of enrolling in the advanced college counseling program.

The requirement for high quality counseling staff

Expansion within our existing locations, as well as the opening of new centers, will create new opportunities at all levels for the next academic year and beyond for experienced college counselors and recent graduates of U.S. universities. With the number of students planning to apply to U.S. universities increasing, we are significantly expanding our college counseling program and offerings. Appointments will be available in A Level and AP centers for:

- Experienced college counselors to serve as consultants in our in-school and advanced college counseling program for contracts ranging from three-months to two years.
- Graduates of top U.S. colleges to serve one year contracts as academic and cultural ambassadors to students in our counseling program.

What do we look for?

Expatriate college counselors must have strong university guidance experience at high school level and the qualities and enthusiasm to share their expertise with teaching faculty, Chinese college counselors and, of course, students.

Recent graduates employed should have a recently acquired degree from a well regarded American college or university, a passion for education, a desire to explore a different culture and an interest in the college admissions process.

Our model, in all aspects of our work, is to provide western educational methodologies within a Chinese cultural context. For all staff, appreciation for a different culture and an understanding that cultural differences do exist is very important.

Students

Our model, by working with highly regarded public high schools, offers educators, counselors, and those interested in education a unique opportunity to teach high-ability, extremely committed Chinese students who are eager to learn. One of the key aims within each center is to adequately prepare our students for successful university careers and for life overseas, in part developed through a modern, western style of teaching that encourages critical thinking, debate and application of learning. Students are keen to learn about western culture and higher education in preparation for their own post-secondary goals. Our students, above all else, make working in China a very special and rewarding experience.

Schools

Our partner schools have unique histories and cultures, yet common themes emerge across all of them: high standards, committed students, and a belief in the all-round development of young people. From the oldest school in the world (where our A-Level center in Chengdu is based) to the most recently developed institutions, the commitment to the success of these programs and recognition for the contribution foreign teachers and counselors make, is undoubted.

Company

As one of the first (and leading) western curricula providers in China, Dipont has the experience to understand the demands of offering foreign curricula to Chinese students and the methodologies required to deliver a successful program. Our senior management team incorporates individuals from both Chinese and western cultural backgrounds ensuring cross-cultural ideas and communication. Our proven model allows us to further extend the range of our curriculum services to AP and IB programs and to provide a variety of related educational services required by Chinese students, including college counseling. Growth over the next few years will be extensive in this ever-developing market, and Dipont is currently the leader in this field.

Culture

The cultural experience is fascinating and a fantastic opportunity for anyone with an interest in exploring this dynamic, diverse, beautiful and rapidly developing country. The chance to work alongside Chinese educators, to share educational philosophy, and to generally understand more about Chinese culture is also very rewarding. The food is wonderful and diverse across provinces, the opportunity to learn Chinese is available to all our staff and you are welcomed into this engaging culture on all levels.



Professional development

For experienced college counselors, our posts provide a unique opportunity to shape and further develop a counseling program and mentor a new class of college counselors. In the national Chinese school system, college counseling is not provided. Our Chinese counselors are the first of their kind in advising students on their college preparation and applications in a school-based, international college counseling setting. Your guidance and consultation with these bilingual and often Western-educated young professionals is a rewarding way to share your skills, experience, and wisdom with a new cohort of college counselors.

For recent graduates just starting their careers, a year in China serves as an excellent introduction to a country that continues to develop rapidly on all levels. Our program is a perfect opportunity for recent graduates keen to experience living in and learning about a new culture, enthused about working with young people and keen to share their knowledge of U.S. culture and society. Our position can also be a wonderful fit for students of Chinese interested in developing their language skills while also engaging in cross-cultural exchange with Chinese high school students.

Benefits, Package and Support

Our salary and stipend package is very competitive and other benefits include good quality housing or a housing allowance, round-trip airfare and medical/accident insurance. Staff also benefit from a considerably lower cost of living compared with the West, hence disposable income is high. In being part of a network of schools, there is also the opportunity to travel to other centers and to our headquarters in Shanghai during your time with Dipont.

Recent graduates additionally have the option of taking up to 3 hours a week of complimentary Chinese lessons, tailored to one's level and needs, and are also given a 2-3 week vacation during the Chinese New Year.

Before you start

We will manage your visa process and entry into China and ask you to attend an orientation program before school starts or at the outset of your arrival. This allows you to meet all key staff from Dipont. This training will provide information about the company, Chinese culture as well as the academic and professional requirements of your role. A separate new staff orientation is typically provided in each center in terms of information about your new city, school and center. Our support staff organize your accommodation and assist you in all other matters required to establish your base and life in China.

When in post

You are assisted with establishing your life in China by a center coordinator, and supported by college counseling and faculty staff. Our management team travel around the centers on a regular basis to provide further support and direction.

Locations of Dipont Centers

Beijing, as China's cultural and political center, has a wealth of historical sites, modern architecture and a diverse range of activities on offer. From the Forbidden City, Summer Palace and The Temple of Heaven to a vibrant nightlife and a burgeoning art scene, Beijing is a community – there's a vast array to choose from.

Nanjing was the former capital for China during the Ming dynasty and, for a brief time, before the establishment of the People's Republic of China in 1949. It is now the modern, attractive and cosmopolitan capital city for Jiangsu province - with tree-lined streets, historical sites and arts scene.

Xi'an is the prosperous capital of Shaanxi province. It is an ancient city and was the imperial capital between 1000 BC and 1000 AD. It has a vibrant culture with a wealth of historical sites - including the Terracotta Army, the Bell and Drum towers and the city walls from the Ming dynasty.

Chengdu is the capital of Sichuan province and is one of the largest cities in China. It has a long and fascinating history spanning the past 2400 years and is famous for its spicy cuisine and relaxed lifestyle. Sichuan province itself is a beautiful area to explore, and Chengdu provides easy access to Tibet.

Wuxi is another canal town with beautiful lake scenery and also boasts the world's tallest Buddha. Well located in Jiangsu province, it's only 45 minutes from Shanghai or Nanjing and very close to Suzhou. It has a great balance of 'real' China, with modern China very close by in Shanghai.

Fuyang is located 38km away from Hangzhou in Zhejiang province and is an ancient city with a population of around 680,000. The Fuchan River winds through the countryside surrounding the mountains, waterfalls, lakes and

Zhangjiagang is a small city in Chinese terms, but still has a population of some 1.2 million through the city and outlying areas. It is well located close to Suzhou, Wuxi, Nanjing and Shanghai. It is a modern, clean, tranquil and affluent area and was selected as a model city for China in 1993.

Suzhou is known as 'The Oriental Venice' with its network of canals and bridges. It is also famous for its traditional style of gardens, architecture and silk products. Proximity to Shanghai (about 40 minutes by train), has certainly helped the city develop a real cosmopolitan and modern feel against a more traditional backdrop.

Ningbo is one of China's oldest cities (dating back to 4800 BC) and has a long history as a vital port city for the whole of China. The thriving city economy offers a wide variety of attractions and some interesting tourist sites in and around the city. In 2008, a 33km sea bridge created an easy road link to Shanghai.

Hangzhou is often referred to as 'the most beautiful city in China' with its stunning central lake and surrounding countryside – the modern city having grown and developed around the lake. It is the capital of Zhejiang province and offers a wealth of amenities and activities.

Shenzhen is reputedly one of the fastest growing cities in the world. Due to its proximity to Hong Kong, it was chosen as the country's first Special Economic Zone in the 1970s and has benefited from a huge level of investment. The climate is subtropical with some very attractive and dramatic landscape surrounding the modern city.

Partner Schools & Teaching Centers

A Level Centers:

The High School Affiliated to Renmin University, Beijing

RDFZ is considered to be one of the best schools in China and is consistently placed at the top, or near the top, of league tables for Chinese schools. The school's leafy campus is situated within the education zone of the city and has a wide range of excellent sports facilities, laboratories and lecture theatres. The main school has 5,000 students and the A Level Centre (in its 6th year of operation) currently has 400 students on roll from 14 to 18 years of age.



Beijing National Day School, Beijing

Beijing National Day School was established in 1952 and has more than 5,500 Chinese students, from 12 to 18 years of age. The school is also extremely highly regarded with a continuing aim to ensure its status as a model school in China. The campus is extensive (over 156,000 square metres) and has more of a university feel, providing students with modern, first-class teaching conditions and facilities. The A Level Centre opened in August 2009, currently has 160 students on roll and will be expanding further over the next few years.



Nanjing Foreign Language School, Nanjing

NFLS was founded in 1963 and there are approximately 4,000 students on roll, ranging from 12 to 19 years of age. The mission statement for the school is: "To educate our students to be open to international understanding in a modern world whilst maintaining their Chinese soul", which is certainly a philosophy echoed by all our partner schools. Competition for places at the school is fierce and the school has scored at the top of league tables for Jiangsu Province over several years. The A Level Centre was opened in 2006 and currently has 316 students enrolled.





Nanjing Jinling High School, Nanjing

The school enjoys a central location in the city and has a beautiful, extensive and well resourced campus. Established in 1888, with many eminent graduates over the years, it currently has 2,500 students from 16 to 18 years of age. The school has a strong belief in the promotion of education to enable all-round development and provides a wide range of extra-curricular, as well as academic activities. The A Level Centre opened in September 2008 and has 211 students on roll.



Suzhou High School, Suzhou

The school was originally established in 1032 and has around 2,700 students from 13 to 18 years of age. It is another provincially and nationally recognised school and has won numerous awards as part of its status as a model school. Located centrally in Suzhou, with beautiful gardens surrounding the campus, teaching facilities are good and the school also runs a wide range of extra-curricular activities. The centre was established in 2007 and has 268 students on roll.



Wuxi No. 1 High School, Wuxi

Located in a very attractive 5 acre campus, Wuxi No. 1 High School also benefits from its setting close to the downtown area. The school opened in 1912 and has 2,000 students on roll from 15 to 19 years of age. It is a key school in Jiangsu province and has received accolades on a national level. The A Level Centre opened in 2008 and has good sporting and academic facilities. 230 students are enrolled on the A Level programme.

Partner Schools & Teaching Centers

Hangzhou Foreign Language School

HFLS was established in 1964 and has approximately 2,500 students on roll from 12 to 19 years of age. The ethos of the school is to develop excellent high school graduates with outstanding foreign language skills, solid academic knowledge and creative ability. The campus has a university feel and is located in a stunning setting. The A level Centre was established in September 2008 and has 280, high ability students enrolled.



Ivy Experimental School, Zhangjiagang

A modern school, having opened in 2000, it currently has about 2100 students on roll from 12 to 18 years of age and has already won a number of awards for high standards. The campus covers an area of over 80,000 square metres with excellent facilities. The school is committed to a student-centred approach and a focus on preparing students for lifelong development. The A Level Centre opened in 2005 and has 117 students.



Chengdu Shishi High School, Chengdu

Shishi High School is the oldest known school in the world having operated continuously on the same site for 2,150 years. It has been a reputed key school since 1949, with an excellent reputation on a national level, and has 2,000 students from 16 to 18 years old. It has also achieved 100% in students' enrollment at university for decades. The A Level Centre opened in 2005 and currently has 129 students in the programme.





Ningbo Zhenhai High School, Ningbo

The school campus encompasses several acres and has stunning gardens and fish ponds. The school has a wonderful history, with parts of the campus also devoted to excavated artifacts. It has an excellent reputation and academic standards are high. Located outside the city centre, close to the port area, the surrounding urban area from the school is quiet and relaxed. The A Level Centre was established in 2008 and has 180 students on roll. Resources are good and the centre also runs a range of extra-curricular activities.



A Level & AP Centre:

Xi'an Gaoxin No. 1 Middle School

Xi'an No. 1 Middle School was founded in 1995 with a current enrollment of 1,800 students. The school enjoys the reputation as the most comprehensive and academically challenging secondary school in Xi'an. The centre opened in 2006 and has over 300 students, with access to an excellent range of facilities. It is unique in the Dipont network for introducing the AP curriculum alongside the existing A Level offering.



AP Centers:

Chengdu Foreign Language School

Chengdu Foreign Language School was established in 1989 and is one of 13 foreign language schools approved by the State Ministry. Most of the 5,800 students are boarders, with an age range from 13 to 18 years old. It is one of the best schools in Chengdu and Sichuan Province, and has the right to recommend students for admission to key universities without the need for entrance examinations. The AP Centre, launched in September 2009, has 150 students and 6 foreign teaching staff.

Partner Schools & Teaching Centers

Jiangsu Tianyi High School, Wuxi

The motto of Jiagsu Tianyi High School is 'honesty and sincerity'. The campus covers 320,000 square metres and is extremely attractive, with a pavilion, rockery with waterfalls, bridges over a river (in which fish can be seen swimming) and beautiful gardens. The school, established in 1946, has over 3,000 students and is a national exemplary high school. The centre was established in September 2009, with 162 students and 6 foreign teachers.



Shenzhen Foreign Languages High School, Shenzhen

Shenzhen Foreign Languages High School is considered the most rigorous and desired high school in Shenzhen. All graduates qualify for college admission in either China or abroad. The AP centre opened in the spring of the last school year and presently has 105 students enrolled. The centre offers AP economics, physics, chemistry, statistics and calculus as well as academic English. Additional resources are available to provide supplemental study in TOEFL and SAT preparation and the centre hosted US college admission fairs during the summer and autumn.



Shude High School, Chengdu

Shude High School started in 2007 and has an enrollment of 3500 students. "Shu De" can be translated to 'cultivate personality and character' and therefore, in addition to the more academic subjects, Shude High School also emphasises sports and the arts. The Shude Foundation Program began in July 2010. It is a one-year English immersion program, focusing on English, US High School Math and Physics, coupled with intensive TOEFL and SAT preparation. Students take AP Exams in Calculus and Physics in May.





Xishan School, Beijing

Xishan School is a school administered by RDFZ and is located about 20 minutes from the main RDFZ campus. It opened in the summer of 2009 and currently has 550 middle school and Senior 1 (10th grade) students. Student enrollment is expected to increase substantially over the next few years. The campus has outstanding facilities and is extremely well resourced. The AP centre opened in August 2010 and has over 80 students studying within the programme.



Fuyang No. 1 High School, Fuyang

Fuyang High School is a well-established key school with an outstanding reputation based on the excellent academic record of its students and quality of its teaching staff. The new campus has modern, and well-equipped facilities within a beautifully landscaped setting. The school enrolls students from throughout the Hangzhou area and Zhejiang province. The AP centre opened in September 2010 with 80 students and 5 foreign teachers. The programme is a natural fit for a school with a history of strong international relationships, annual teacher and student overseas exchanges as well as intensive English summer camps.



Company background

Dipont was founded in Australia in 1990 as a private emigration and visa consulting company, focused primarily on providing advice, support and services to Chinese students studying overseas. In 1994, Dipont began roll-out in mainland China and established branch offices in Beijing, Shanghai, Nanjing, Chengdu, Xi'an, Shenzhen, Chongqing, Hangzhou and Wuxi, in addition to representative offices in the US, Canada, and the UK.

In 2003, Dipont became a senior subsidiary center and associate partner of the University of Cambridge International Examinations (CIE) in China. This was a further milestone for the company in entering a new sector to provide direct educational services to Chinese institutions and students, allowing Dipont centers to teach and administer the UK A-Level program. Dipont adopted the strategy of cooperating closely with provincial educational administrations on behalf of CIE and individual public high schools. Great success has been achieved with this strategy, and Dipont has become the largest provider of the CIE A Level program in China.

In 2009, Dipont became authorized participants in the AP (Advanced Placement) Program, and we are currently in the process of developing an IB (International Baccalaureate) curriculum. We began our in-school college counseling program in 2009.

Additional educational programs have developed over the past 15 years, including 'High School Year Abroad'; special courses for gifted and talented students; short-term educational camps; an Au Pair program; 'Teach in China'; and 'Work and Travel' programs. It is estimated that over 25,000 young people have participated in these Dipont programs since 1994.

Mission Statement

Academic Programs

Students who wish to join our programs transfer to our A-Level and AP courses once they have completed either their nine year compulsory education or senior years one and two in the Chinese system. In all cases, students are keen to study at higher education level overseas – particularly in the U.S, U.K, Australia, New Zealand, and Canada.

The A-Level Program

Cambridge International A/AS-Level is an internationally recognized curriculum, taken by students in over 125 countries. The Dipont Cambridge program includes IGCSE for Pre A-Level (PAL) and the CIE AS and A2 levels. IGCSEs are taught within one year, with students then moving onto the AS and A2 program. Expatriate teachers teach predominantly at AS and A2 level.

Subjects offered are Mathematics, Further Mathematics, Physics, Biology, Chemistry, Economics, Business Studies, ICT, and Accounting. English is a compulsory subject for all students throughout the program, even when they have met English entrance requirements (IELTS/TOEFL) for overseas universities. Students can choose 4 to 5 subjects at AS level and in most cases take 3 to 4 subjects at A2 level. The Chinese school system places a great deal of emphasis on mathematics and sciences and therefore many students enter our A-Level centers with a very strong academic background in those subjects. Their background in business studies subjects is limited and therefore more support for these courses is required in the PAL year.

The AP Program

Advanced Placement courses provide high ability students with the opportunity to earn college credit while in high school and to stand out in the admissions process to colleges in the U.S., Canada, and other parts of the world. Dipont has developed a coordinated curriculum that builds on the strength of the Chinese National Curriculum through the study of AP and academic English courses.

In some parts of the world, secondary school students can take AP examinations without having taken AP courses. The College Board, however, strongly recommends that the best way to prepare for an AP exam is to take a specifically developed AP course. For most Chinese students, whose learning follows the Chinese national curriculum, taking the AP exam without undertaking a specific course is unrealistic due to the requirement to master concepts, display critical thinking skills, and study particular content. Our students greatly benefit from our more concept-driven AP courses that can build upon their previous learning.

We currently offer AP courses in Calculus, Physics, Statistics, Chemistry and Economics. English is taught to all students as a separate subject. Over the next two years, we will further develop the range of AP subjects available to our students. As in the A-Level Centers, students take a Pre-AP year in order to prepare them for their first year of AP study.
